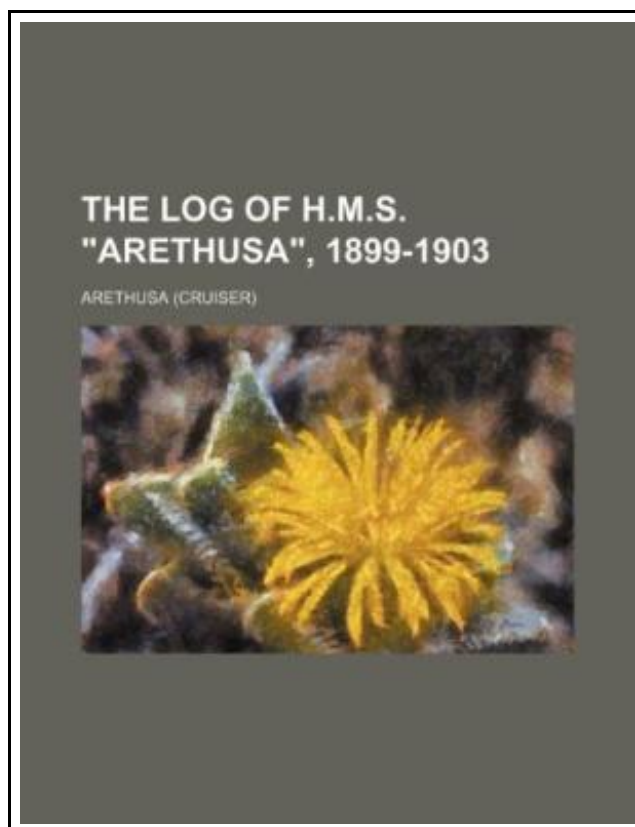

Eleven men fired in each team, first ten to count. November 19th. --Coaled ship. November 21st. --A football match was played against the Royal Welsh Fusiliers on Happy Valley. This match was only another point for each team, as it ended in a draw with no score. November 23rd. --In the afternoon a football match was played against H. M. S. Brambles team. This match was played and watched with great interest, as our opponents were supposed to be one of the best teams on the station. Our team played with perfect skill, and after making a few splendid runs up the field, proved to be the fastest team, and scored three goals to their opponents one. November 25th. --Some of the fleet left--H. M. ships Albion (flag), Ocean, Argonaut, Waterwitch, and Tweed, and the German cruiser Iltis. November 27th. --H. M. S. Cressy arrived, being a new addition to the station from England. Two Italian cruisers, Vesuvio and Lombardia, arrived. Marines from fleet landed for sham fight at Kowloon. November 28th. --H. M. S. Glory (flagship) and the Italian cruiser, Vettor Pisani, arrived; the latter fleet were mustered here, homeward bound to pay off. Later a Portuguese gunboat arrived. In the afternoon a football match was played against H. M. S. Auroras team. This match was watched with great interest by both ships companies, as all who met our team wanted to beat them; and this time they did it, the Auroras...
