Stearns of Boston had been engaged for several years previous to this date in experiments on simultaneous transmission, or, as he called it, duplex telegraphy. In principle his apparatus did not materially differ from that of his predecessor and contemporaries, and until 1872 his success was not more marked than theirs. Early in this year he introduced the condenser 1 into what is known as the artificial or compensating line, thus overcoming the only serious obstacle to success.
