

S. interests by Iran, in particular by Irans advancing uranium enrichment program. Well before the Iran nuclear issue rose to the forefront of U. S. concerns in 2003, the United States had long seen Irans support for militant groups in the Middle East, Iraq, and Afghanistan as efforts to undermine U. S. interests and allies. U. S. officials also accuse Iran of helping Syrias leadership try to defeat the armed rebellion there and of trying to block resolution of the unrest in Bahrain, a key U. S. ally in the Persian Gulf. The Obama Administration has orchestrated broad international economic pressure on Iran to try to compel it to verifiably demonstrate to the international community that its nuclear program is peaceful. Three rounds of multilateral talks with Iran in 2012 yielded no breakthroughs but did explore a potential compromise under which Iran might cease enriching uranium to 20 purity (a level not technically far from weapons grade) in exchange for modest sanctions relief. Further discussions on that potential agreement took place on February 26-27, 2013, and March 18, 2013, with high level talks to re-convene on April 5-6. However, no breakthrough is expected in advance of Irans June 2013 presidential elections. Irans Supreme Leader has, to date, refused to engage in direct bilateral talks with the United States that many experts believe would be required to produce a breakthrough. And, there is an emerging consensus that international sanctions- although severely harming Irans economy-have not pressured the regime to the point at which it is compelled to compromise.
